Project Capoeira



In August we got to do 2 sessions of Capoeira with 25 local children! Capoeira is an Afro-brasilian art using music, singing, and animal type movements to connect the capoeiristas in a game where no one loses or wins. It is a form of resistance developed by African slaves to preserve their culture disguised in a dance. During the workshop, the children sang songs, learned a bit about the history, played percussion instruments, practiced defensive, attacking and disguising moves and got to play with a capoeirista and between each other. Finishing the workshops to the chorus of " Nablus que tem dende " which means " Nablus has the Strength " .



Italian Delegations



HSA has welcomed two Italian delegations this month. The first group was 25 people, and the second one was 38 people .

We introduced them to the association through some short videos. Then, topics about the association were discussed with them such as the activities that are being provided to the different groups of the society .



Then, we introduced them to the children and show them their talents such as Dabkeh .

The children performed for them this traditional . dance and all of the group joined them .

After that ,we took them on a tour around the old city of Nablus in order to show them the historical part of Nablus and to give them a historical and political background about the situation here .



The BAFA training aimed at teaching volunteers Youth leaders skills. They learnt how to lead activities for groups and children .



The program also focused on learning about Child development, rights and duties of youth leaders as well planning and logistics . The volunteers developed their skills and knowledge through participatory and dynamic worksops delivered by HSA staff EVS volunteers and EU Aid Volunteer .



The course that lasted 30 hours over 5 days included 3 different workshops : Group games energisers/ Icebreakers, Psycho drama and/ Handicraft. All the participants received an official BAFA certificate at a the end and took a picture together .



Arabic Language

HSA continues to deliver Arabic lessons for the EVS volunteer " Olivier ", he learned Vocabulary and Alphabets and started how to read and write really wel . The EU Aid volunteer " Leila " learned verbs and how to make sentences. During this month there were three classes for different levels. A new French and Czech volunteers "Solène, anna" came and started to learn basic Arabic " Vocabulary and Alphabets". The volunteers started practicing the language with people everywhere as well as writing down the new vocabulary .





English Language



This month HSA has started providing English Classes to youth and adults. The first class aimed at looking at the students levels. Educational and fun games were organized so the students get to know each other and practice their speaking and listening skills .



This class was attended by 12 people and allowed us to divide

the group and set up 2 classes according to the people's levels : A beginners class and an advanced class was then set up

The beginners class will last 1 hour and will be for students with little knowledge of English who want to communicate in English, and develop basic speaking reading, writing, and listening skills.

The advanced class will last 1 hour and a half and will focus on conversation through which students will improve their speaking and listening skills .

Workshop for children “ learning Dabkah Dance ”

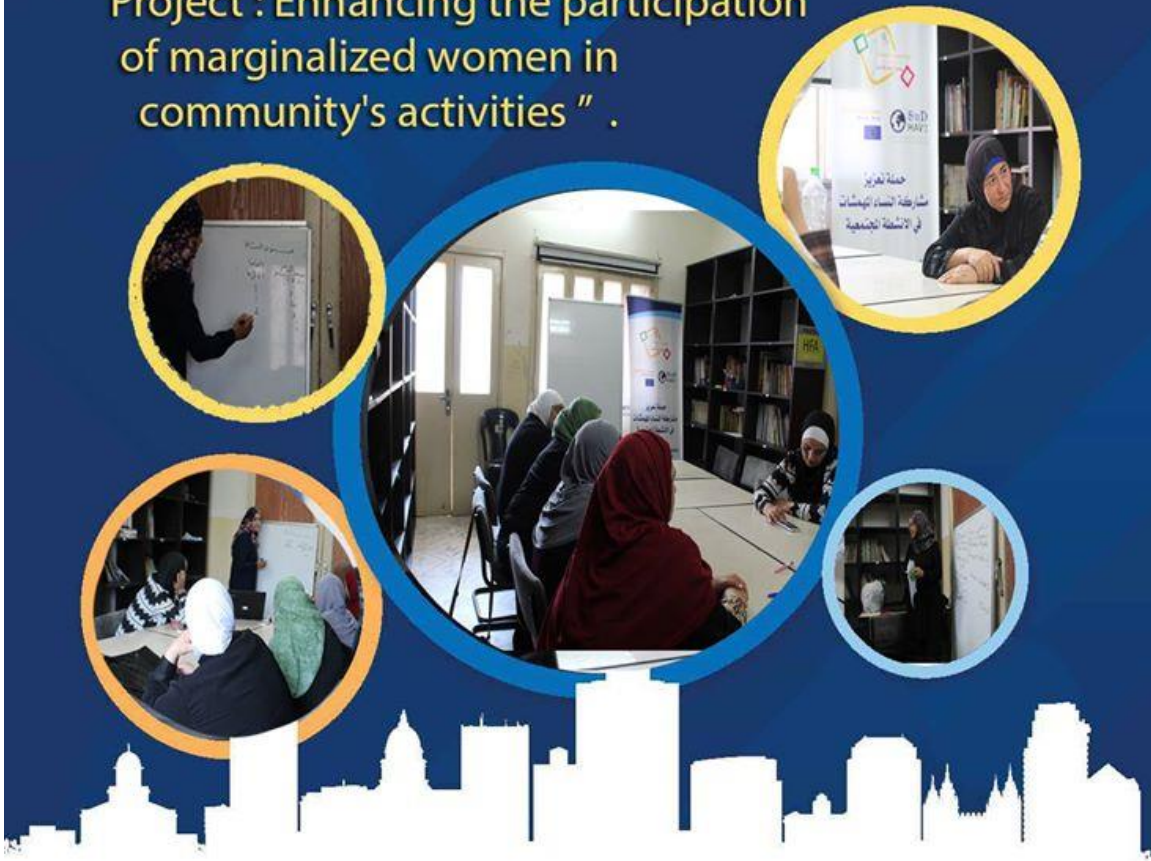


HSA Continue training Dabke for children by “ Tala trainer”, one day a week ,in Thursday the children came after schoolm at 2:00 pm .
