It was a good time for all of them and for the public who have had the chance to watch some of the games.


















At the beginning of October, the teachers made exams for students to know their educational levels at the school support. They then started teaching them in a non academic way, through which students can easily understand letters, numbers.

Workshop For Children CIRCUS
