## Project “ Enhancing the participation of marginalized women in community's activities “



In September, Human Support Association organized a training for the women call “ Enhancing the participation of marginalized women in the community's activities”. This training was one of the activities that HSA provide through SuDHAV program . We had several meetings and trainings for mothers and girls . The main purpose of the training was to give the participants tools to provide a positive way of educating their children in their daily lives. One of the activities was to explain to the parents the importance of the use of non-violence and punishment during the child's upbringing. We trained parents how to find alternatives ways, how to raise their children in a peaceful and non-violence way. We gave women an opportunity to participate in the meetings and to be part of the group, share experiences and problems between each other's, as well as building friendships . Meetings were happening once in week at 10:30 am in HSA center .

HSA organized a concert in cooperation with the Danish band "Oktoberkoret" consisting of 25 people, Taranim band of HSA, and the participation of the Palestinian artist "Murad Sweiti".



The orchestra performed in different places such as Al-Quds Open University, at Child Cultural Center for elder people, in Qalqilya city and refugee camp Askar.





Festiclown Palestine a yearly Festival organized by HSA and our partners Pallasos en Rebeldia and Rivas Municipality – Spain. The partnership started in 2011 implemented by clowns in a cooperation with many clowns and and was circus teams from around the world .We hosted this year 35 clowns and activists from around the world in solidarity with the Palestinian issue. There were different performances in several areas in the West Bank. Activities started in Askar refugee camp and Jenin camp and were spread to government schools Six government schools were targeted in Nablus in cooperation with the Directorate of Education and reached some villages such as Bazaria and in the Jordan Valley. In total they offered a total of 12 ceremonies, a street show in the Old City of Nablus and workshops entitled “Therapy through laughter”. During the workshops for children and volunteers, they used recycling materials to build musical instruments, did art activities and group games and cooked Spanish recipes . All of these activities were implemented within few days only . Thanks to all of you, you were great .

## Workshop “ Children protection ”



HSA is continuing its workshops in a cooperation with “Palestinian Counseling Centre” for children aged 10-15 years old. The workshop is happening twice a week and it starts at 1:30 pm. The workshops are about “Children protection from violence and harassment .

One of the main objectives of the course is to educate children about self-awareness and protection .

Beginners group has 12 members and conversation class has 13 members. Beginners class mostly focuses on practicing grammar rules, speaking and listening.

Lessons always start with energizers as we believe that it brings students closer to each other and gives more confidence to speak.

The advanced class is mostly about practicing speaking and listening and focuses on team work. Topics are always discussed and agreed by the students for the following lessons.
